2. Declaration of interest in items on the agenda

3)<u>Planning</u>

a) <u>Householder application for the erection of a two storey</u> <u>rear extension- White Cottage, Main Street, Carlton-on-</u> <u>Trent</u>

All present perused the plans provided. Mrs Clark stated that she did not think the property was big enough for the extension. All in agreement with the application as the application has not generated any objections from neighbours and the growing family at the property required more room. Proposed by Mr Cooper and seconded by Mrs Jerome- all in agreement.

b) <u>Continue use of the annexe as a dwelling - Beck Cottage</u>, <u>Church Lane</u>, <u>Carlton-on-Trent</u> Mrs Whate, having expressed an interest, remained silent throughout the discussions.

Initially the Parish Councillors debated what is being asked of them as this is not a planning application, but an application for a Lawful Development Certificate. No one present appeared to know what this was. Mrs Clark spoke several times about supporting the application, however the remainder of the Parish Councillors did not feel that they could support or oppose as they were unaware of what they were being asked to make judgement on. Mr Cooper suggested that we reply to Kelham Hall to say that as far as the PC were aware, the property was being used as a dwelling and that we did not know what we being asked to consider. The majority of the PC agreed with this course of action with 3 in favour and 1 against.
