I have had the analysis carried out and am going to send to you via 'wetransfer' the paint sample form and paint analysis report. This I am doing because the paint sample form is too big to send as an attachment to an email. Please download the documents as soon as is reasonably possible as the window for download is restricted to around 5 days. To this email I attach my invoice for the work carried out (£75.00 + VAT) as indicated in earlier correspondence. The results of the analysis show that the white material is either crushed chalk, limestone or marble. It is quite possible, therefore, that the material we see in the carved lettering is a very fine lime mortar with crushed limestone or marble as the aggregate. If the lettering were to be re-filled it would be desirable to use something similar.
