

Clerks Report for the Uffington Parish Council Meeting Monday 9th March 2026.

I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

Correspondence was received from two residents requesting further discussion relating to planning application P26/V0100/O. There have been no requests for a Special Motion from council members to consider this.

Defibrillators:

None of the units have required use and are all available for use.

The clerk is currently in the process of updating the 'Circuit' register.

Fix My Street: The following new reports have been registered.

Multiple reports have been made regarding the current condition of road surfaces in the area. This is recognised not just as a local issue but one of county and national concern and is being treated as a high priority issue by District and County representatives.

General:

The interim audit has taken place, attended by Cllr Purdie and the clerk. Recommendations made by the Internal Auditor are to be discussed at the March Parish Council meeting.
