## Youth clubs/ Wildlife Watch clubs:

Saturday 29th April (Morning) Fernwood Finches (6-8 years)

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> April (Afternoon) Fernwood Falcons (9-16 years) These would run every last Saturday of the month

I think getting lots of activity in during the half-term will be really beneficial to the site to help keep vegetation trampled because it's growing quickly already and we don't want to be using an unmanageable site.

If you can confirm use of the woodland on these dates as soon as possible that would be most appreciated for me giving the nursery, school and residents enough notice. It'll also help Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust be clear on when I'll be running sessions for them too.

If you don't think the wood will be on site before the first weekend in April just let us know and I can liaise with Nottinghamshire WT in getting their wood as orginally planned.
