<u>Fire Safety Training</u>: It remains an annual requirement for all club officials / volunteers to complete fire training. <u>Social Media</u>: With several group Facebook pages existing, the Directors would be grateful if Administrators / Moderators of those groups made themselves known via email to the General Secretary, please. This will

support completion of the BDA Club Risk Assessment and alignment of the Social Media Policy. Responses are requested via the General Secretary by 30th April.

<u>Security</u>: There have been a couple of instances reported during the past month, where padlock combination codes have not been scrambled. Please could all members ensure this is done on <u>every</u> occasion padlocks are removed / reattached.

<u>Chirping Smoke Detectors</u>: There are various reasons why battery-operated smoke detectors occasionally 'chirp' however, this can be easily remedied by pressing the Test / Reset button located in the centre of the device.

<u>New Cash Register</u>: The club has invested in a replacement cash register to support stock auditing and accounting. Although instructions can be found in the manual provided, a series of short training session will be arranged on a 1-2-1 or Team basis. Please contact Ian Swift to make arrangements.

Risk Manager's Monthly Report:

All fire extinguishers, fire blankets, smoke detectors Eye Wash and First Aid Box have been serviced and confirmed serviceable. Arrangements are being made to complete the annual testing of Portable Electrical Equipment - further details will be circulated via email, the website and social media once a date is confirmed. Items subject to PAT include Fridges, Kettle / Boiler, Cash Register, Heaters, Extension Leads, Mobile Phone and Sum-Up Chargers and Electric Groundskeeping Equipment, and is a 'condition of insurance' imposed by clauses in the club's insurance policy. Jennifer Murray


