- be a British citizen, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union, and be at least 18 years old.
- in the past 12 months have occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in the parish; or
- work in the parish (as your principal or only place of work) during the preceding 12 months; or
- during the whole of the preceding 12 months resided within 4.8 kilometres of the parish boundary.

You can't be a councillor if you:

- work for another local authority in a political restricted post
- are the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or interim order
- have been sentenced to prison for three months or more (including suspended sentences) during the five years before election day
- have been convicted of a corrupt or illegal practice by an election court.

You will be required to attend ten meetings each year, which are held on the second Tuesday of the month. Plus any additional meetings that are convened from time to time.

The position is to be filled by Co-option and not by public election.
