Matters arising:

Para 5:b: BLL11: White Cottage, Battle Hill recorded as omitted from issued draft list

Para 5:b: BLL22: The Thatch, 97 Hastings Road recorded as omitted from issued draft list

RDC proposals that the following should be promoted to the local list:

- BLL32 165,167 Hastings Road do not concur with RDC. Our previously issued assessment still considered valid
- BLL34 181 (*Rose Cottage*) Hastings Road insufficient information for conclusive decision. RDC to be requested to iterate their assessment of significance
- BLL67 *Virgins Croft* TN33 0JJ Group value noted but uncertain that is sufficient to promote to local list. RDC to iterate their assessment of significance
- BLL104 52 High Street (*Taylors of Battle*) agreed to promote to list and revise description of significances
- BLL106 65-65b High Sreett Bakers & Demelza agreed to promote to list and revise description of significances
- BLL 401 Railings Mount Street noted that only three posts are historic, others being recent reinstatements. RDC to comment. Envisage promotion to local list with aspiration that replacement posts should match historic originals

Buildings in our 'rejected' category actually Grade II listed:

• BLL109 87,88 High Street - listed GII in 1961 but misidentified since list entry has names *Market Green Cottage* and *Abbey Green Cottage*. No further consideration required.
