- Private, **George Edward Benbow**, 48427, 16th Bn. Royal Warwickshire Regiment. Killed in action in France 23 August 1918. Buried at Adanac Military Cemetery, Miraumont, France. Grave IV. F. 27.
- Lieutenant, **Thomas Brooke Benson**, 2nd Bn. Royal Scots Fusiliers. Killed in action in France 13 March 1915. Remembered on Le Touret Memorial, France. Panel 12 and 13.
- Private, **Arthur Botting MM**, 14491, 7th Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed in action in France 13 November 1916. Buried at Serre Road Cemetery No. 1, France. Grave I. D. 33.

- Driver, **William J. Finch**, T2/017667, 141st Coy. Army Service Corps. Died in the United Kingdom 14 April 1916. Buried at Kenley (St. John The Baptist) Churchyard, England. On North-East boundary.
- Lance Corporal, **William George Kenyon Harper**, 206179, Machine Gun Corps (Heavy Branch). Died of illness in the United Kingdom 7 January 1917. Buried at Cound (St. Peter) Churchyard, England. Grave 385.
- Private, **James Langford**, 18908, 16th Coy. Machine Gun Corps (Infantry). Killed in action in France 12 October 1916. Remembered on Thiepval Memorial, France. Pier and Face 5 C and 12 C.
- Private, **George Richard Lewis**, 11024, 5th Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed in action in Belgium 9 December 1915. Remembered on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Belgium. Panel 47 and 49.
- Private, **Arthur Gerald Longmate**, 18314, 5th Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed in action in Belgium 10 February 1916. Remembered on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Belgium. Panel 47 and 49.
- Private, **Arthur Luscott**, 19127, 1st Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Died of wounds in France 16 September 1916. Buried at La Neuville British Cemetery, Corbie, France. Grave II. E. 31.
- Able Seaman, **Thomas Luscott**, R/2863, Anson Bn. R. N. Div. Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve. Killed in action in France 25 August 1918. Remembered on Vis-en-Artois Memorial, France. Panel 1 and 2.
- Private, **Percy Edward Harold Parsons**, 5304, 1st/10th Bn. The King's (Liverpool Regiment). Killed in action in France 9 August 1916. Remembered on Thiepval Memorial, France. Pier and Face 1 D 8 B and 8 C.
- Lance Corporal, **Frederick Price**, 29172, 1st/4th Bn. The Loyal North Lancashire Regiment. Killed in action in France 14 May 1918. Remembered on Loos Memorial, France. Panel 89 to 91.
- Serjeant, **Madeley Price**, 12204, 6th Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed in action in France 20 November 1917. Remembered on Cambrai Memorial, Louverval, France. Panel 8 and 9.
- Private, **William Price**, 12177, 6th Bn. King's Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed in action in Belgium 12 February 1916. Remembered on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Belgium. Panel 47 and 49.
- Private, **Ernest Rogers**, 551421, Candian Light Horse. Died in France 30 October 1918. Buried at Ramillies British Cemetery, France. Grave G. 26.
- Lance Corporal, **Charles Russell**, 7751, 1st Bn. Royal Welsh Fusiliers. Killed in action in France 16 May 1915. Remembered on Le Touret Memorial, France. Panel 13 and 14.
- Private, **Robert Stunt**, 20755, 2nd Bn. York and Lancaster Regiment. Killed in action in Belgium 21 April 1916. Remembered on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Belgium. Panel 36 and 55.
