Recycling and Waste Collection. Collections are on Mondays, except bank holidays. Bins are emptied fortnightly, on alternate Mondays for recycling and general rubbish. Food waste (the small green bin) is emptied weekly. Garden waste (brown) is emptied fortnightly with the recycling bin; this service is an optional paid subscription through the District Council. Please remember to put your bins out on Sunday night as sometimes collections can be early on Monday mornings. The nearest Waste Recycling Centre ('the Tip') is located on the A417 north of Stanford-in-the Vale.
