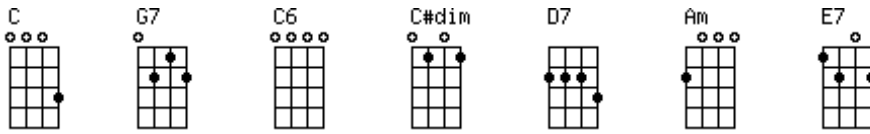


LEANING ON A LAMP-POST
