**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER SEPTEMBER 2022**

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gibbs Hill, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 12th September 2022 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 12th September 2022 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS441090A-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Gibbs Hill will be closed from the junction with Maidstone Road to outside Rock Farm Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2015 Maidstone Road, Bow Road, A26 Tonbridge Road, Pizen Well Road and vice versa.
