- 05.03 Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 28th December 2016 for Approval: Each Councillor had the Minutes sent to them and agreed they were correct. Agreed Cllr Platten Seconded Cllr Smith, minutes were signed by the Chairman
- 05.04 Open Session for the Public -

Martin Wilson from Dot59 came to discuss a new Gunthorpe website, to come back to next meeting with outline options, to send link to give PC ideas

Paul Jeffery to put notice of Parish Council vacancy onto the village Newsletter, he also has access to current website. PC to send details to PJ and put the notice onto the village noticeboards

05.05 NSDC, Highways and Other County Matters, – Cllr Jackson Cllr Platten expressed concerns about parking issues and the need for a drop kerb/parking bays to help alleviate some of the issues, he is prepared to talk to Newark & Sherwood Homes to discuss the issues and antisocial behavior

Cllr Simpson voiced complaints about buses picking up and dropping passengers on Main Street in the early mornings and late nights creating noise and disturbance, she has previously contacted the bus company directly to complain with no success. PC to contact the bus company MJ Tours of London Road Newark to request them to use the official bus stop and turning point and not to use the slip road.

Cllr Everington expressed concerns about vehicles parking on the pavement outside the car sales forecourt on the A6097 causing pedestrians to have to step out onto the very fast busy carriageway Cllr Jackson to contact NSDC Enforcement
