Introduction of £1 fee per person, per league

The committee, regretfully find they have no alternative but to re-introduce this fee. As explained at the AGM we have a £5000 overspend: that is income against expenditure. Whilst there are reserve funds that can cover this deficit, we must ensure that the club can function fully based on income alone. If we do not and we continue to use up the reserve funds, the club will fold within 2 years.

We do not want to put all this onus entirely on members and are researching other income streams in order that the £1 fee can be withdrawn at the earliest opportunity.

Constitution Update

It was agreed to update the constitution in order that current practice for the Ladies Section of the club is reflected in this important document. The constitution details the principles and procedures for running PLCIBC. It guides the committee in its role and ensures fair treatment of club members.

Special General Meeting

This meeting was held on Wednesday 26th July and was well attended. The main points from the meeting are set out here.
