

We have had many complaints about speeding vehicles in the Parish and have been considering various measures to combat this concern.

We are following up approaches made to Shropshire Council to pursue long-held convictions that 30 mph limits need extending in several areas of the Parish.

The Parish Council has resolved to buy, initially, two vehicle speed monitors which can be moved around from location to location. If they are found to be effective the purchase of additional ones will be likely.

The monitors will not only advise drivers if they are exceeding the relevant speed for the road but also record statistics that will show the number of vehicles passing and the speeds they are travelling at. The statistics will help us to prepare a sound case to ask for further action from relevant Authorities to make our roads safer.

The monitors DO NOT record any vehicle details that will lead to prosecution.

There are two Councillors who now have responsibility for this area of our work.

We would like to involve members of the Community in the Speed Monitoring Scheme and we ask that you contact our clerk if you are able to help in this important project. Amongst the work to be undertaken is downloading information, placing of monitors and advising on any action relevant to combat the danger of speed.

Full information will be given once we have a team set up.
