Parking on Station Close has been raised with Tom Pettit PCSO who will monitor the situation.

- c) Flood Wardens – David Scott, Tim Sheldon, Caron Ballantyne – anyone else would be welcome. NCC are going to be providing training for closing roads etc.
- d) Speed gun – is now working and has been out for several days this week and will be out again tomorrow
- e) Removal of waste hedging, Moor Road – work is now complete
- f) The Cricket Club are going to try and get the ball rolling by getting all the sports groups to meet to see how they can work together. 7:30pm at the Cricket Club on 29 September.
