DON'T BE AIR CONNED

I've been looking at new cars of late and I was surprised at how much has changed since I last took a look about 5 years ago. I recently read that motoring costs have now grown to exceed grocery costs in the "average" family budget. Strange you might think – since the purchase cost of cars has dropped so dramatically in this time.

Regular service costs might well be lower since cars now have longer service intervals – but what seems very very costly now are replacement parts. Costs of headlight assemblies of high-volume super-mini type cars can be over £200 each. A very costly (to repair) feature of many modern cars is the air con. Conned you may not be if charged four figures for the repair of a failed system. That is the going price these days – even if you only paid £300 for it as an option!

Having learned that, I have a seasonal tip – for all air con owners. Many air cons are switched off completely during the winter. This leads to critical seals drying out which in turn leads to a loss of refrigerant which leads to failure of the compressor.

You should turn on the system to full cold for a couple of minutes every week during the winter. This will circulate lubricants for the system and seals. Ideally then use the system on heat to dry out the ventilation passages where mould may accumulate.
