

Minutes from last month's meeting

E met in June at Wye Methodist Church because the parking area outside the hall was being resurfaced.

We had an interesting speaker, Mrs Alison Carter, who was talking about a charity called Dementia Friends. This was an interactive evening for our members and thought provoking.

Mrs Carter started by asking us what words we associated with dementia and throughout her talk she brought those words in and expanded on them.

Dementia isn't a natural part of ageing and is caused by a disease of the brain. Of 95% of cases of dementia, two thirds of those are Alzheimer's.

One in 14 people over the age of 65 has dementia. It can affect perception – for example, seeing a black mat on a floor may look like a

hole. Mrs Carter told us a story of a lady in a nursing home who was continually tapping.

When her niece visited from New Zealand she told the staff that her aunt had been involved in the Enigma code-breaking work and had been using Morse code a lot during those years. The lady then became involved in teaching Morse Code to Scouts.

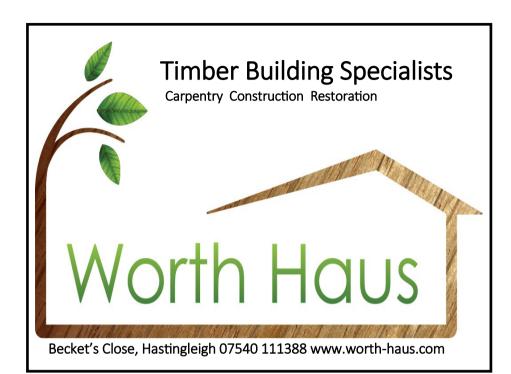
Mrs Carter recommended a book *Being Mortal*, by Atul Gawande.

The Parish upon the Hills

HREE years ago, I was living in colourful, noisy, Brooklyn, New York, and thoughts of the inner workings of Wye Church were far from my mind.

Fast forward until now, and I find myself and my family happily ensconced in the house that I will always think of as my Mother's and engaged enough in church and village life that I have been elected Churchwarden.

I can think of few positions that sound so stuffy and middle aged as Churchwarden. It doesn't have the glitz and glamour or spiritual responsibility of a clergy position, nor the creative appeal of Music Director or Flower Lady.

When Ravi asked me if I would consider taking on the job, my first inclination was to splutter indignantly - clearly this could not be a position for me - I don't go to church every Sunday, my faith, while strong, will never be described as devout, and really, Churchwarden sounds about as boring as a job can get.

However, something stopped me from saying 'No' immediately and as I learnt a little

about the job, I began to see that while a warden's job is partly tiresome administrative stuff (just which is the right energy company to provide heat to an ancient building? How are we going to pay for the new pews?), it is also about community.

We are lucky enough to have a thriving church community and the wardens play an important role in maintaining the smooth running of that community, making sure that all the people involved are working happily together, but also helping the church family integrate with the wider village community.

Many of you fondly remember my Mum, Dickie Cleveland. She loved her job here and was deeply spiritually engaged.

Even more than that, she was concerned with making sure that every single person in this parish, whatever their beliefs, felt noticed, welcomed and loved.

While I don't have anything like her level of skill in making people feel seen and heard, I do share her commitment to maintaining a strong

church community who are able to open their arms and offer friendship and help to anyone in the village who needs it.

In this increasingly secular world, it is easy for the church to seem redundant, but I think that an institution that is inclusive and non-judgmental, which welcomes everyone in their hour of need, will never be redundant.

As warden, I feel that my responsibility is to these values and helping this message come from the church and there is nothing stuffy or middle aged about that.

Tales from the archives

20 May 1856, The Kentish Gazette

AN inquest was held last week on the body of Daniel Brooks, an agricultural labourer in the employ of Mr. John Sankey, of Hastingleigh, who came by his death through, as supposed, the kick of a horse.

According to the evidence of a fellow servant, William Knott, deceased, who was mate, had been to Wye, and returned home in the evening the worse for liquor.

After supper he went to see about the horses in the stable; and afterwards was found in an out house, he having received a severe injury on the front part of his head.

Witness found one of the horses loose, and it being believed that deceased might have received the injury from it, a verdict was returned of 'accidental death'.



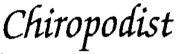
