Parish Council News

Yorkshire Water

Yorkshire Water have cleared out the dyke by the treatment works, so hopefully we will have no further problems. Moving forward, the plan is to have it cleaned out bi-annually, and to maintain the dialogue we now have with Yorkshire Water with the aim of solving the other drainage issues within the village.

Speed survey

A speed survey was carried out last summer, and the average traffic speed recorded was 26 mph, so let us keep up the good work, taking care to keep our villages safe.

Street Lights

Street lights in both villages are to be replaced with LEDs, which should reduce our lighting costs to one third of what they are now. We have been promised this work is imminent.

Memorial Wood

The charity "The Conservation Volunteers" have provided a wood planted in the Parish Council owned field by the crossroads. It has been named The Queen Elizabeth II Memorial Wood and will be maintained by them for five years.
