

Basic Rules for Spring/Autumn Triples Competitions

1. All matches to be played on Monday afternoons, 2pm start unless notified otherwise.
Each player will give the Skip 50p before commencement of play.
2. Play will commence at the bell and last for 2 hours. If the jack has been centered before the finishing bell sounds, the end will be completed.
3. Each player will have three woods, there will be no trial ends and the home team on the card will have the mat.
4. Only one score card will be used and 2 points will be awarded for a win and 1 for a draw.
5. If the jack is improperly delivered it will be placed at a legal length by the opposing Skip, the mat will not be moved.
6. Play will generally be in accordance with World Bowls, Crystal mark edition three.
7. Rinks will be drawn by the organizer before each week's matches and allocated in the order shown on the fixture sheet.
8. A team causing a dead end will give 2 shots to the opposition.
9. If a full team cannot be fielded from the team squad, teams must find a reserve to complete the team. This can be;

Any Club Member not already in a team.

Any stand down player from another team (providing they are not playing against their own team).

The reserve selected cannot play as Skip.

If a full team is not fielded, 25% of their score will be deducted.

The team winning the end will bowl the jack, but the first wood will always be played by the full team.

The full team will have nine woods and the pair, eight woods.
