"It is proposed that the successful Bidder will retain all income. Your proposal should include an annual contract fee, the surplus shall be invested into the Jubilee Field following agreement with the Parish Council."

All three shortlisted contractors have been informed.

In simple terms they will be keeping all the income, this in theory should help reduce the ongoing management fee.

The add value becomes more important to evaluate, as this is how they will invest surpluses into the site moving forward. "Key questions at interview –

- What are their proposals?
- How can they guarantee them?
- What would be the impact of contributing funding towards construction of 3g pitch?

If all three shortlisted contractors are informed the same information they could also add value by contributing to the construction of the 3G pitch project
