

## S106 Working Group Meeting – 5/02/25 – 5pm on Teams

Present: G Merry, R Wallond, R Simpkins, A Flatley

- RW followed up from the public meeting on 22/1/25 and circulated the consultation responses so far. The results will be published but this is an ongoing process. He advised re. those volunteers who had contacted him, with a view to joining the working group:
  - A Hanslope School Governor with link to Sport England
  - The chair and vice chair of Hanslope Hornets
  - A community sports expert who works for All people active

It was discussed and agreed to invite all to join the WG. GM will set up a mutually convenient time in approx. 2 weeks, to have an in-person meeting. Further interested persons can be brought on in due course, for more specialised areas.

- RW shared his spreadsheet of the responses, grouped into similar types of projects. GM pointed out that some of these are likely to be incorporated into the refurbished Community Hall e.g. coffee shop, learning space/community library, kitchen, classes and potentially a youth club.
- GM stated that MKCC own and manage the play equipment in the Rec. and had approached last year with a view to an upgrade, using S106 money. It may be possible to nudge them to progress this, based on some of the responses. The unused POS to the north-western end of the Bloor estate, may also be considered for play equipment after it has been transferred to the PC.
- It was agreed to look at the sums available and separate out those on RWs list that are outside of the scope of a parish council. AF suggested making the list more auditable in due course, using a scoring system to prioritise ideas. The list will be published once it has been edited.
- RS suggested investigating the criteria for public art, as this may be applied to projects such as increasing the number of benches. GM will follow-up.
- GM is following up with Sustrans re. instating the cycle path from Castlethorpe to Hanslope.
- GM will follow up on references from the 3 shortlisted architect's practices, with a view to inviting them to a more in-depth discussion.
