Andrew Chappell reported a small loss on the recent Presentation Lunch which the Patrons Association had generously covered.

### 10. Championship/Competition Secretary

Brian Pocock further reported that competition entries were up for the first time in many years. In addition, he thanked the many Clubs for offering their greens for the later stages of competitions and appealed for one last green (preferably in the south of the County) on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May to hold the Two Wood competition.

There were questions:

- 1) Why had the Two Wood been moved from evenings to a Sunday? He explained this was at the request of many members who preferred the 'old format'.
- 2) Why had the printed Handbook been scrapped without a full consultation with the membership? He pointed out that the idea had first been floated at the Spring Communication Meeting and feedback sought. With little input from Clubs or members the Board and Council felt it was time to make the change, thus reducing the significant financial deficit (£4500) on competitions.
- 3) Where there to be changes to the Competition Rules? Yes. They were to be updated following an overhaul of the Bowls England Rules & Regulations and would be explained at the Spring Communication Meeting.
- 4) Was the suggested relaxation in the qualification for the Honorary Secretaries' competition taking effect in 2019? No. The position is still being monitored.
- 5) What happen to the suggested changes in the Fear Cup (reduce from 3 rinks to 2 rinks)? Despite asking for feedback from all Clubs the response had been very poor. The decision has been deferred until the Council next meet in April 2019. Gen Sec to diarise.

### 11. Performance Manager

Subsequent to her report Edna Bessell had received details of proposals to be placed before the Bowls England Counties Meeting later this month:

- 6.1 Bowls Dorset
  - The Amy Rose Bowl be amended to be a single Rink entry, with a maximum age of 25 years and only 2 entries per County.
- 6.2 Bowls Dorset
  - The Johns Trophy is played as a knockout Competition (to be considered in conjunction with Proposition from Middlesex Bowling Association -6.3)
- 6.3 Middlesex Bowling Association
  - Johns Trophy is played as a knock-out competition, played to Group Final within Group, and, with the semi-final and final played during the National Championships at Royal Leamington Spa. All rounds of the competition to be played on Saturdays on dates specified by Bowls England, with the draw made in advance for two years.
- 6.4 Bowls Dorset
  - The Johns Trophy and Middleton Cup area for the West of the Country reverts to the following Counties: Cornwall, Devon, Dorset, Somerset and Wiltshire.
- 6.5 Bowls Dorset
  - The Middleton Cup be scheduled for Sundays instead of Saturdays.
