





Your Vision for Exbourne

You may be aware that Exbourne has been designated a 'main village' by West Devon Borough Council ('WDBC') in its emerging Local Plan. At least 20 new houses are planned in our parish over the next 10 years and there is the distinct possibility of more as the Local Plan is revised.

Changes in legislation mean that we can be more involved in influencing this kind of development as well as conservation. A Neighbourhood Plan for Exbourne would reflect the needs and values of the whole community and allow us to conserve and enrich our parish. It would have the same legal status as WDBC's Local Plan, meaning it would have statutory weight when planning applications are considered.

A volunteer group is helping the Parish Council produce a Neighbourhood Plan and wants to identify the key themes and issues we should focus on as well as our community vision for the Exbourne of the future. What do <u>you</u> value about living in Exbourne and what could be made better? We need to particularly look at development and land use, so you may want to consider areas such as housing (type, design, and location), green spaces, the conservation area, the playing field, footpaths, facilities, provision for business, roads, parking, flood and water run-off control, street lighting, protecting wildlife, renewable energy, what the Exbourne landscape should look like – we want to know your views.

The questionnaire is ANONYMOUS. Please fill it in so we know what is important for the future of Exbourne, a place after all, mentioned in the Doomsday Book.
