# 19 **AOB**

Councillors raised the matter of the potholes on Mill Lane which have appeared in the same place where work was done last year. The Clerk is to write to Highways raising this issue.

Broadband is on track for Spring. Councillors requested the Clerk send a letter of support from the Parish Council to Shropshire Council regarding the need for the 3<sup>rd</sup> level of Connecting Shropshire programme. The company Airband will be providing this service, filling in gaps in rural areas. It will require a clear line of sight to properties from the transmitter. Planning Permission will be needed to erect the transmitter. A decision is expected on 15<sup>th</sup> February.
