* OBJECTION Unjustified incursion into open countryside contrary to policy for the following reasons; The intended entrance and track width is wider than Stratford Road itself. The removal of two established parish trees is unjustified given the previous assurance (withdrawn application) that no trees would be removed. There is existing access already in use for the canal restoration which continues at a snails pace and has done since 1990 and whilst the attached report suggests, that the traffic would be of a higher tonnage it remains unspecified; Not sure what swept analysis of typical vehicle use is or what is untypical to those already using the existing access; This is not an agricultural permitted development for a field access onto farm land and with no firm planning intentions other than aspirations, the application should be refused on these grounds alone.
