What are we consulting on?

Kent County Council owns and is responsible for the preservation of eight historic windmills across the county. Our windmills have high heritage value and are considered important local landmarks, but they also require significant expenditure for their ongoing maintenance and repairs.

We are proposing to find alternative arrangements for the ownership of and/or financial responsibility for each of the eight windmills owned by KCC, which would be a change to our current strategy for windmills as set out in the Heritage Conservation Strategy.

We welcome views from members of the public, windmill and heritage volunteer groups, residents and other interested parties.
