



The Kingsclere Neighbourhood Development Plan

Neighbourhood Planning gives communities the opportunity to have a say in the future development of new homes, businesses, shops and community buildings. Plans can allocate sites for future development and also say how developments should look. To be adopted by the Borough Council they must meet two basic criteria:

- That they fit with the Borough's Strategic Policy; and
- That they are approved by a simple majority of the community in a local referendum.

In order to develop planning policies that meet the future needs of the Parish of Kingsclere, we are consulting first with households through this questionnaire. We will also be consulting with other stakeholders such as the Health Centre, clubs and societies, the churches, businesses and other statutory consultees. To be a truly representative plan, it is important we receive as many completed questionnaires as possible. We would like all members of households to complete the form. 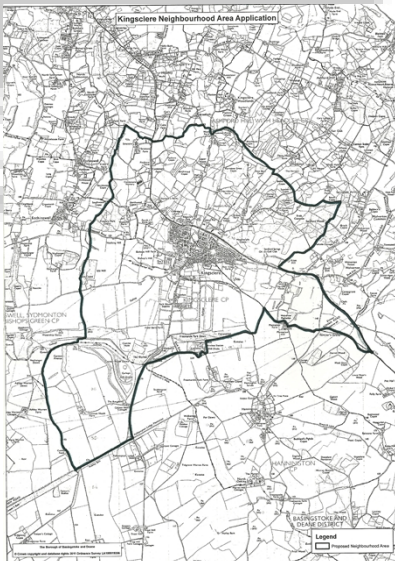
