

<b>Name/timing of market</b>	Glastonbury Farmers' Market Fourth Saturday (not always the last!) of each month (9am - 2pm)
<b>Address and postcode</b>	The Market Place, Glastonbury, BA6 9EU

<b>Indoor/outdoor</b>	Outdoor canopy market set up around historic Market Cross in the centre of town.
<b>Table provided/needed and space available</b>	Own table needed – approx. 2.5m frontage sharing a 3m x 3.5m canopy
<b>Electricity</b>	Electricity available (£2) but must be requested in advance. Own extension lead needed. Equipment must be PAT tested.
<b>Parking information and costs</b>	Unload quickly on pedestrianised Northload Street before reparking. There's Pay & Display parking over the road in the Abbey car park or in St Johns car park.
<b>Toilet information</b>	There are public toilets in both car parks.
<b>Best place for a coffee</b>	Hot drinks are available from Heaphys café which is next to the market. Or there are numerous other cafes near by.
<b>Any other useful information about the market for a new trader</b>	The longest established farmers' market in Somerset relatively recently relocated to present venue. The Christmas market occasionally needs to takes place on the third Saturday to fit in before the 25 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>Costs</b>	£23 on the day; £21 on invoice (£5 discount for veg/plants)
