Once ordered, waymarker discs would be sent to the clerk, the public right of way issue would be photographed and sent-in and the council resolved to request six ‘public footpath’ signs to install.</p> <p>Cllr. Jago offered help with the parish footpath maintenance this year as part of his sons’ Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme and the cllrs approved this and thanked him. The clerk confirmed that volunteers working for the parish council were insured under their policy. He would forward the official schedules and instructions to Cllr. Jago.</p>
