Wolds Ward Barnoldby-le-Beck Update May 2016

Crime

There have been 83 crimes reported across the whole of the Wolds ward from 1st March to 1st May. Four crimes were recorded for Barnoldby-le-Beck.

A small Christmas tree was stolen from a field in the Barnoldby-le-Beck area on the morning of 4th March.

About 400 litres of diesel was stolen from a truck parked in a layby on the A18 overnight 9th & 10th March.

Overnight 9th & 10th April, an insecure shed was entered at a property on Chapel Lane. A white and grey Cube mtb was stolen.

The fourth report is in relation to a long running neighbour dispute.

There have been no reports of ASB
