Helpful Reminder

From February 2023 non-barcoded stamps that have just the Queen's Head on them won't be able to be used. Special stamps with pictures on and Christmas stamps without bar codes will continue to be valid after this date. If you have too many stamps to use up before this date, you can exchange them for new barcoded ones through Royal Mail's 'Swap Out' scheme. To swap out your stamps, simply complete one of the Stamp Swap Out forms and send it back to Royal Mail along with your non-barcoded stamps. For further information and to find the form, go to this address online: www.royalmail.com/sending/barcoded-stamps You won't be able to pick up a Swap Out Form from the Post Office. If you don't have access to a computer, I believe you can pick one up from your local Delivery Offices' Customer Service Point. But don't panic – you can still use your non-barcoded Queen's profile stamps until 31st January 2023.

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Recreation Ground

With funding now in place for the new play area, we have at last been able to give the go-ahead to the contractors, Playdale. Work should commence in approx. 10 weeks' time and take 2 weeks to be completed.

We would like to thank Villagers for keeping the Parish Council informed when they come across problems at the Rec. We are pleased to report the damaged section of the Play Area fencing has now been repaired and work to remove the downed tree on the western side of the Rec is underway.

We are also looking to improve access to the pavilion via a new step to the main entrance door. This will be funded using a donation from a Villager for which we are extremely grateful.

Highways

Following a request from the Parish Council, the road markings at the roundabout at the bottom of Willets Hill have now been repainted. This should hopefully improve safety at the junction and help visibility at night.

Ukraine Donations

We would like to extend a big thank you to everyone who recently donated toiletries etc for the Ukraine collection. Your generosity has been very much appreciated.

Planning Updates

OL/TH/22/0414 – An application has been submitted for 115 homes on farmland to the north of Foxborough Lane, Minster. The site is not included in the Local Plan and has attracted strong opposition from Minster PC and residents. We discussed the application at our recent PC meeting and agreed to support Minster's opposition – this is a greenfield site, where the developer is trying to gain approval using the leverage that TDC has failed to meet local housing supply. This is the same argument as the one being used on the Heyhill site. Further info on the Foxborough plans is available across social media, the local press and on TDC's website.

Pastoral Reflection from Diana Davies: Lay Minister Emeritus to the Wantsum Benefice

Repair and renewal?

I wonder if you, like me, watch the TV programme 'The Repair Shop'? Into a barn in Sussex are brought all manner of damaged goods which often appear beyond repair: clockwork long since stopped, paintings faded and grimy, soft toys falling apart, wooden and ceramic items now cracked and chipped and sometimes broken in small pieces, upholstery and clothing torn and misshapen, leather goods dried up and shrivelled.

In fact, most of it looks ready for the rubbish tip!

It is only when the stories behind each item are told, that we can begin to understand why they are so valued by their owners.

A long loved childhood toy, a hand-made gift from a loved one who has died...each item, though now in a dire state, still holds precious life enhancing healing memories.

Waiting in the barn to welcome both the owners and their 'treasures', and to listen carefully to their stories, are a community of highly skilled men and women who undertake the repair of these seemingly worthless offerings.

When the owners have left, we viewers watch whilst, with utmost patience and skill, each item is lovingly repaired. ...motors work again., paintings are cleaned to reveal their original detail and colour; all manner of brokenness and dryness and decay is repaired and treated.

When the owners return, and their treasures are revealed, there are gasps of astonishment and often tears of joy as their stories come to life, and for a moment, folk are reunited with their loved ones. They leave full of thankfulness and praise.

It is not just the objects that are restored! Those who do the listening and restoration work, too, seem to find a good deal of pleasure and satisfaction as they exercise their skills and gifts to help others.

Perhaps in our village communities and churches we might take more time to listen carefully to one another's stories? As we welcome the many people moving into new homes among us, who knows what life giving stories, gifts and skills they may have to offer? We may find ourselves and our village communities refreshed strengthened and renewed.

Eligible for a vaccine with a second dose 6 weeks later. With schools now reopened after the Easter Holidays now is a good time to get all your family vaccinated.

Vulnerable and Immune suppressant patients

Are also now eligible for a 4th vaccine, so if you have not received your invitation, please contact the surgery.

<u>Had covid?</u> or been in touch with someone who has, remember it must be at least 6 weeks since your last negative test before you can continue with your vaccination program.

All animals of course but especially Hedgehogs, whose numbers sadly have halved since the year 2000 (State of Britain's Hedgehogs, 2015) and continue to decline each year. The British Hedgehog Preservation society states that as of 2020 they have been classed as "Vulnerable to extinction." (BHPS, July 2020) A clear sign to us all that we need to act now to save them and the eco system that they support.

It is for this reason that I have proposed to the Parish Council a request for the installation of seasonal or permanent 'Hedgehog warning signage' on the roads of Monkton. These will act as a reminder to drivers, to bear in mind the endangered creatures which sadly get killed far too frequently on the nation's roads, especially ours, being in a semi-rural village.

Secondly, I implore everyone to act themselves by following the below advice. In particular, the creation of 'Hedgehog Highways' (A hole level with the ground removed from your garden fence to allow the easy passage of hedgehogs, from your garden to your neighbours.)

These are small simple steps that although are totally purposeless to us, make the world of difference to our Hedgehogs and their population.




