- The Australian pair's game which was introduced at the end of last season will run again this season but will be on Friday nights – more details to follow in due course.

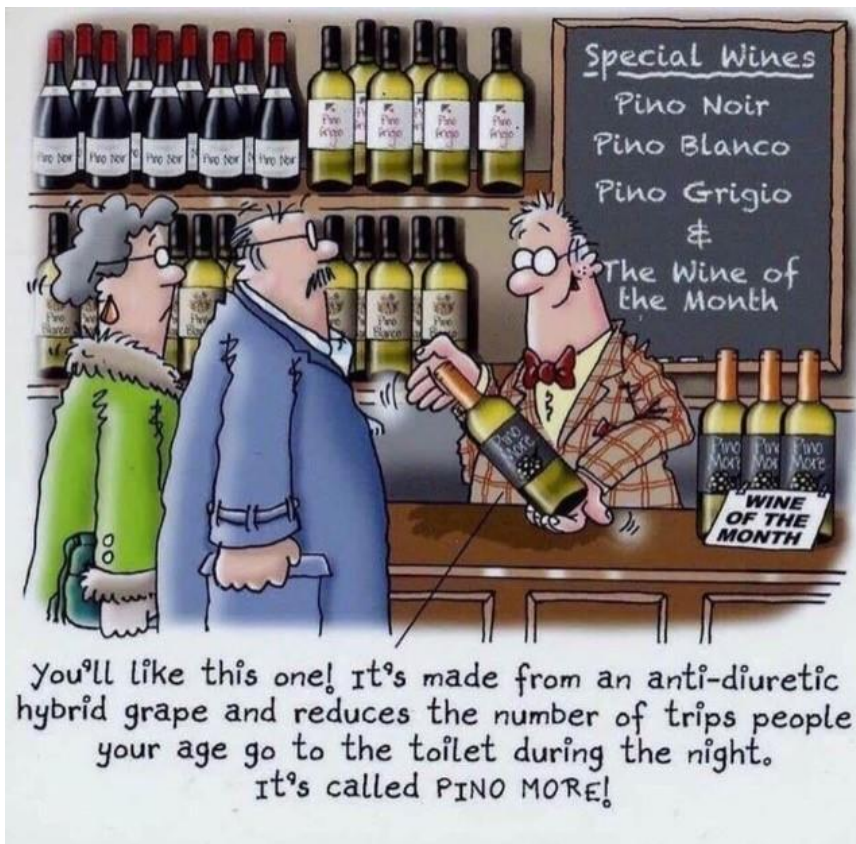
