Repair to Drury Lane road from the entrance to the sign of entrance to the recreation ground. We have 4 quotes 2 from Harrington Brothers one for £4320 with vat and the other for £9480 the other quotes were more expensive they have been doing this kind of work for several years.

1 Windmill Cottage was bought up at the meeting and advised to look into it.

Trees on the Village green need work doing on them was advised as near electric cables contact Uk Power Power network.
