Notes from meeting of 4th January 2018.

At our meeting last week we discussed the programme for the coming year, and here's a synopsis:

1. Speakers / Show and Tell:

- Composters (e.g. as requested by Pam Ayres)
- Planters
- Window Box
- Lathe working (and products to sell)
- Tools for Africa
- Carving
