185 Ironbridge Power Station – Redevelopment 19/05560/OUT and 19/05509/MAW

Members considered how to respond to development proposals at the Ironbridge Power Station site and how it might impact on the parish of Broseley.

Cllr. Simon Harris abstained from the discussion and vote.

The Chairman PROPOSED that the Town Council should take a neutral stance and after being SECONDED it was AGREED to respond as follows:

Although Broseley Town Council takes a neutral stance concerning this development, provision should be taken as to ensure no negative implications should arise from the development which would affect Broseley residents, such as education/schooling or highway. The Town Council will seek the right to request CIL money or S106 monies if Shropshire Council does not remedy the situation and the Town Council has to look at remedying a negative impact itself.
