The Chairman updated the meeting on the proposed defibrillator for Lower Basildon which it is hoped can be sited in the old telephone box. The Chairman has spoken with a manufacturer about installation and has also contacted the local St Johns Ambulance group about running a workshop to show how it works at the Village Hall. Further updates will be provided in upcoming meetings and the Chairman will check that the phone box has power running to it.

The Clerk asked for approval of the standing orders document which had been circulated in advance of the meeting. It was confirmed that amendments requested by Councillor Couchman had been made and a query

by Councillor Chadwyck-Healey addressed; the meeting voted unanimously to accept the new version of the document.
