# Site 3b: Land at The Grove, top of Church Hill

#### SITE DESCRIPTION

Slightly sloping site, garden to The Grove cottage. Adjoins cemetery to east, close to church and with farmland to west and south.

#### PROPOSED USE

Housing

# **ACCESS**

Existing Access from Church Hill – narrow with no pavements. Unsurfaced footpath connecting to A354 and St Andrew View

DCC comments: single width carriageway approach to the site, no segregated pedestrian provision. Possilbly one or two residential units, at most

### **ENVIRONMENT AND LOCAL FEATURES**

Within Conservation Area and close to Grade II\* St Andrews Church Potentially prominent site, clearly visible (as on higher ground on village edge) from footpaths to the south and also impacting on character and tranquility of church and cemetery

Tall tree screen to east side (recently partly removed)

Area has been recently cleared – apple tree retained and hedgerow boundaries Japanese knotweed (invasive species) noted at site entrance

## **OTHER**

No major constraints noted.

### **OVERALL**

#### Proposed mitigation requirements:

- Limit total number of dwellings based on highways advice
- Strengthen landscaping along site boundaries, and limit scale of development, to provide softer transition to cemetery and with countryside (particularly when viewed from south)
