## HGVs in the village: recent damage caused by

large Heavy Goods Vehicles transiting the village. Whilst restrictions

cannot be imposed on use of the A32 due to its classification, both Winchester City and HCC are working with the Parish Council to address the issue on other roads. A number of 'Unsuitable for HGVs' signs are currently being produced and will be positioned to discourage large, heavy



vehicles from using any roads other than the A32 as a throughroute. This is a very positive step in dealing with one of the main traffic related problems, noting that the signs have no legal force if drivers chose to ignore them. To view full version, click <a href="here">here</a>.
