Transferred to the National Trust in 1978, the property is a late seventeenth century mansion and an example of a traditional Shropshire country estate comprising the Hall (with its remarkable collection of modern art), landscaped gardens, parkland, managed woodland, lakeside, farmland and estate cottages.

Quatt is an example of a model estate village, designed by London architect John Birch in 1870 for the workers and tenants of the estate.
