2311. APOLOGIES.

There were no apologies.

2312. PRESENT.

Planning Applications have been received concerning:-

18/03219/REM – Approval of reserved matters (landscaping layout and scale) pursuant
to planning permission 15/01817/OUT – Outline permission for the erection of an
essential occupational workers dwelling (all matters reserved) – Kernow, heath
Common, Shropshire. **Councillors supported this application.**

18/03455/TCA – Removal 2no Birch and 2no Field Maple within Rushbury
Conservation Area, The Old Rectory, Rushbury. **Councillors had no objection.**

18/03355/FUL – Change of use of former public house to residential (resubmission of
17.01687/FUL) – Longville Arms, Longville in the Dale, Much Wenlock.

Councillors objected to this application.

18/03836/FUL - Application under section 73A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for change of use from a dwelling and sale/making of dresses to an open market dwelling. Longlea Farm, Longville in the Dale, Much Wenlock. **Councillors were divided but the majority supported the application.**
