# 5.1 LIST OF APPLICATIONS FROM: 28/4/22 TO: 6/6/22

#### DC/22/0736/HH

Planning Application – 13 Seymour Avenue, Brandon

Extension and alteration of existing detached garage, front and rear access ramp. Cllr Brabbs introduced the application made by the householder. Planning Application – 3 Walton Way, Brandon

One Silver Birch – coppice and one Oak - crown reduction.

# 5.1 DC/22/0842/FUL

Planning Application - Land off Chalk Road, Brandon Change of use of land for dog walking purposes.

Cllr Brabbs asked if any members of the public wished to speak on this subject. The applicant stated that the land was for personal use to provide a safe secure location and biodiversity had been considered. Cllr Brabbs asked if this land was already in use and therefore should it not be a retrospective application. The applicant replied it was already in operation and that they had been trialling the facility and had now been advised to apply for planning permission. A member of the public confirmed that the landowner rents many fields in the area and they generally supported the application but had a number of concerns regarding the vehicular access creating a safety issue, and that there is no water supply or services to the land. The applicant replied that the vehicles attending the land do not need to go as far as the residents house and they do not need a water supply as the period of operation of the facility will be in one-hour blocks. Cllr Brabbs queried how many vehicles would be using the facility. The applicant replied possibly fifteen to twenty, maximum. Cllr Lukaniuk offered his support to the application. Cllr Vant added that at a similar operation there was no toilet facilities and no resulting problems. A resident stated that toilets maybe needed as it was expected that families may use the facility. Cllr Moore confirmed that up to four dogs at a time maybe using the facility and asked what happens with dog mess and who cleans it up? The applicant stated that prior to his occupation of the land it was a dumping ground for waste and that the land will be checked and cleared by personnel in his employ. It is a condition of the use of the ground that any waste is cleared from the site. A resident wished to make it clear that no notification had been received regarding the planning application and this matter was to be taken up with West Suffolk by the Clerk. Cllr Brabbs suggested a number of options which Brandon Town Council could adopt to reply to this application including referring it back to West Suffolk as the applicant was a member of the Council. Cllr Lukaniuk stated he could not see any reason why a decision could not
