## **Control Measures Section 1**

- Signage erected at all play areas to advise of the following
- Users are asked to adhere social distancing guidelines at all times.
- Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19 should not enter the play area.
- Users are asked to keep the number of parent, carers or guardians accompanying children to 1 where possible.
- Users are asked to spend no longer than 30 minutes in play areas during busy times to reduce the amount of people within the space.

- encourage effective sanitation by users, parents, guardians and carers, asking for children's hands to be sanitised before and after use of the play area.

- parents, guardians or carers should dispose of all litter including any used protective wear such as face coverings or gloves properly in litter bins, taking it home where a bin is not provided.

## **Control Measures Section 2**
