CLUB COMPETITION RULES

- 1 All singles matches will be played with 4 woods and to a score of 21, except for ladies two woods which will be played over 21 ends.
- 2 All pairs' competitions will be played with 4 woods per person over 15 ends. In the event of the scores being level after 15 ends an extra end will be bowled to determine the winner.
- 3 Trial ends at the beginning of the match are discretionary and agreed between players before match commences, if no agreement can be reached no trial ends will be bowled. There will be no one shot on first two ends rule.
- 4 Rinks are drawn on the day to determine which rink to be played on. The rink cannot be drawn until all players and markers are present and no changing of rink is allowed once the draw has been made.
- 5 In the event of a dead end the end will not be replayed.
- 6 In the event of bad weather, the match can be suspended with approval of all players. It can be recommenced once it is possible, but only if the green remains playable. If play cannot be recommenced players should seek to book an alternative date. If no alternative date can be agreed the result will stand at the suspension of the match provided 8 ends have been bowled. If this is not possible players should contact the Competition Committee for clarification.
- 7 Club shirts are to be worn for all competitions, and once match is complete, all scorecards should be pinned up next to the competition noticeboard in the club house. The score should also be annotated on the relevant competition sheet in the club house.
- 8 In the event of any disputes, all disputes should be forwarded to the Competition Committee (S Prole, J Venter and J Campbell) who will resolve the dispute. The Committee's decision is final.
- 9 Any player who is in breach of any of the above rules is liable for disqualification from the relevant competition.
