17.32 Lengthsmen – Footpaths & ROW

- 17.32.1 The lengthsmen completed all but one of the tasks the footpath from Union Lane Car Park to Chestnut Rise and removing the goalposts off the Recreation Ground (not on the list). The main task being to strim the verge of the Square. Lengthsmen cleared the beginning of footpath 16 next to Lark Rise of nettles at the Mill Lane end. The Council will contact the landowner to request the land be adequately maintained. **ACTION BC?**
- 17.32.2 Footpath 17: The landowner has granted permission to install a kissing gate where his land borders the small paddock adjacent to No 4 Whitelands. Waltham Ramblers have agreed to install a kissing gate, free of charge to the parish, to replace the current stile. HCC will supply the kissing gate free of charge. The Council will approach the landowner of the paddock and No 4 Whitelands to request permission, all other

necessary permissions and agreements to install having been obtained.
