65 MATTERS ARISING

65.1 Upper Farm Barn Conversion

EG had spoken to the planning officer who had said that the project would have to be allowed as a permitted development.

65.2 Highway Repairs

- Highways said they would not repair the road at Wellbourne corner until Thames Water had fixed the leak.
- Highways had said they would repair the bridges at Cuddesdon Mill in July.

65.3 Fence at Denton Green

Following a meeting at the location, Anthony Kirkwood from OCC had said it was unlikely that the traffic speed exceeded 30mph. To install a restriction would cost the Parish Council about £4,000. It was agreed not to proceed with this.
