On the 5th of December there was a reported commercial attempt break in the High Street. Footprints have been seen on parts of the door as it was kicked in order to gain entry. Two panes of glass were smashed. The offenders were unable to gain entry. It would appear that the offenders were looking for cash.

The public order registered above is in regards to the public order offence is a domestic police responded to where the offender then became verbally abusive in the street and there arrested and a crime generated.

A student was detained at the Cotswolds School for bringing a knife to school. There was no threat to any other person and the incident has been dealt with.

On the 16th of December a youth was seen to be carrying an imitation firearm along the High Street in Bourton on the Water which prompted a firearms response as it

was unclear if the weapon was a firearm or a BB gun. The youth was arrested due to the seriousness of the offence and taken to Custody.

Several hours before this incident a window was smashed down a footpath. The offender used a brick. It is unclear if the firearms incident above is linked to this or this was a genuine break.

Please be aware of NHS scams by the phone. There has only been one report in Bourton on the water however the other cases may not have been reported. Please be aware and challenge those that call from companies.

On the 24th a drink driver crashed his vehicle off the Kingsbridge. The driver was arrested however blew under at cells and was free to leave.

Bourton On the Water NPT have set up a POP plan to target ASB which has occurred in the area. This is mainly down to youths congregating, making noise and leaving rubbish. PCSO Perrett, ALLAN and PC 1501 will be in the area.

I am now leaving Bourton on the Water, I am sorry I couldn't make a parish meeting however I have been in a position whereby I have been juggling two areas. Pc Francis WARD is now taking over the responsibility of BOTW from the 1st of January and I will remain in Cirencester.

I would like to thank the Parish once again for your support and patience with myself and the team. Policing at this minute in time is very challenging and like many jobs were are all struggling for staff, however I still urge residents to call in suspicious incidents, reporting at the PIP and calling 101 and we will do our best to resolve your issues.
