KILLED IN ACTION.

Much sympathy has been extended to Mr. and Mrs. J. T. Hawkes, 4, Burton Place, Upper Halling, who have just received intimation from the War Office that their son, Gunner George H. Hawkes, No. 65,750, 104th Battery, R.F.A., was killed in action "somewhere in France" on September 26th. Deceased was a fine, promising young soldier, and most respected at Upper Halling and by his comrades. He joined the R.F.A. five years ago, at the age of sixteen, and was consequently only 21 years of age. On the outbreak of war he was serving in South Africa, where the above photo was taken. He visited his parents on September 26th, 1914, for the last time, and, by a sad coincidence, was killed on the corresponding date this year.
