RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLING CLUB CONSTITUTION & RULES

NAME & PREMISES:

The Club shall be called RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLING CLUB.

ADDRESS:

FARNBOROUGH RECREATION CENTRE,
FARNBOROUGH, HAMPSHIRE

OBJECTS:

The objects of the Club shall be, in conjunction with the Farnborough Recreation Centre, to promote and further the game of Bowls and Social Activities between members themselves and members of other Clubs with similar objectives.

AFFILIATION:

The Rushmoor Indoor Bowling Club shall be registered in due form with the E.I.B.A., E.W.I.B.A. and the Hampshire County Indoor Bowling Association.

MEMBERSHIP:

Membership shall be open to all, independently of their membership of any other Club. Membership of Farnborough Recreation Centre is a prerequisite of Rushmoor Indoor Bowling membership and the appropriate fees must be paid annually as they fall due. The rules of conduct of the Farnborough Recreation Centre and the Rushmoor Indoor Bowling Club that may be in force or notified from time to time be observed and any member wilfully damaging property or contents belonging to either the Centre or the Club shall make good the same to the satisfaction of the Officers of the respective section.

OFFICERS (Men's Section):

The Officers shall consist of the Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Captain, Vice-Captain, Hon. Match Secretary, Hon. Hampshire County and Patrons Representatives and Centre Management.

(Ladies Section):

Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary, Hon. Match Secretary and Centre Management.

SECTION COMMITTEES:

The Men's Section Committee shall consist of the Officers plus three additional members. The Ladies Section Committee shall consist of the Officers plus two additional members. These Committees shall hold as many of their own Meetings, during the season, as they deem necessary. A quorum shall consist of 11 Men or 6 Ladies of their elected committees. Said Committees may call a full meeting of their own respective members at any time. All Officers and Committee with the exception of the Centre Management, to be elected at their respective General Meetings to be held in April.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Executive committee shall consist of the Immediate Past President, President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Competition Secretaries of the Men's and Ladies Sections - League Secretary and Match Secretary, 5 other members (2 of whom shall be ladies) will also serve and all to be elected at the Annual General Meeting held in April. Two members of the Centre Management will also sit on the Executive Committee. The Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, League Secretary and Senior Green Steward of the Executive will be elected at the Annual General Meeting. This Committee shall meet at least 4 times a year (September - December - February - April). 10 Members shall form a quorum of the Executive Committee and shall have power to co-opt additional member/s and may appoint such sub-committees as it may consider necessary.

FINANCE:

All matters affecting the income and expenditure of the Club will be controlled by the Executive Committee and/or by a special finance sub-committee as determined by the Executive Committee.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

1. The Annual General Meeting for all members shall be held in April of each year to receive the reports of the Executive Committee and the presentation of the Accounts for the preceding year, duly audited, as well as a statement of the Current Years financial situation prior to audit. To consider any proposals for alteration of Rules. 35 members shall form a quorum. Any two members of the Club may nominate a member to serve on the Executive Committee, (2 of whom must be ladies). All Club members shall be entitled to vote. All such nominations must reach the Executive Secretary at least 21 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting and all nominated persons must have agreed, in writing, to stand. A printed list of the names of the candidates will be distributed to each member present at the Annual General Meeting who will place an X against the name or names for whom they wish to vote. Propositions shall be decided by a show of hands, or ballot if requested by a member. Any vacancy occurring during the year may be filled by a person as agreed by the Executive Committee. The date of the Annual General Meeting must be notified on the Club Notice Board at least 28 days prior to the Meeting and the Agenda must be exhibited on the notice board at least 7 days prior to the Meeting.
2. If the quorum is not reached a second date for the annual General Meeting will be arranged. If, at that second meeting, the quorum is still

not reached, the Executive Committee will have the power to make the appropriate decision.

SPECIAL MEETINGS:

A special General Meeting will be called by the Executive Secretary within 21 days of a written request signed by not less than 15 members stating the nature of the business they wish to discuss. Notice of the Agenda will be posted on the notice board at least 7 days prior to the Meeting. 35 members shall form a quorum. If the quorum is not reached rule 2 above applies.

EXTRAORDINARY OR EMERGENCY COMMITTEE MEETINGS:

The Executive Committee has the power to call an Extraordinary or Emergency Committee Meeting at any time.

REWARD FOR SERVICES:

In conjunction with advice from the Treasurer, any person may be nominated for a reward for services to the Club, on an annual basis, if so desired at the Annual General Meeting - proposed and seconded in writing.

ALTERATION TO RULES:

A Rule may only be altered or rescinded by a resolution passed by two thirds of the members present and voting at an Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting called for that purpose, of which notice of the intention to propose the resolution has been duly given to the Executive Secretary, in writing, for the inclusion on the Agenda of the Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting.

PUBLICATION OF CONSTITUTION AND RULES:

The Constitution and Rules of the Club shall be exhibited on the notice board of the Indoor Club and on joining the Club every member shall be furnished with a copy of the Constitution and Rules of the Club.

RULES OF PLAY

CONDUCT -

All Members will observe, at all times, rules of conduct and play that are displayed.

NOTICES -

All notices placed on the notice board during the season shall be deemed sufficient intimation to all members.

DRESS -

All players must wear smooth rubber soled heel-less footwear and will wear white above the waist with the exception of Club Matches when all whites will be worn. Men will wear Club ties for friendly matches. Ladies may wear Club colours, as approved by their Committee, for league games and their own Club matches.

COMPLAINTS -

Complaints shall be sent in writing to the Hon. Executive Secretary for the Committee's consideration.

HOURS OF PLAY -

Details of session times and matches will be shown on the Club notice board and published on a fixture card of league and match programmes.

CONTROL OF PLAY -

The Green Steward will ensure that green fees are paid on issue of match card. He will also re-allocate any available rinks.

Non-members will be accepted to take part in sessions upon payment of the required green fee to the Green Steward, but will not be permitted to play in preference to members, when sufficient members are wishing to play. Non-members will only be allowed two visits in any one month during Club time.

During Ladies sessions, Ladies will have complete priority of green occupation, but should there be insufficient ladies present, they may either include men in their rinks, or any available rinks may be occupied by men. During Mens sessions, a similar arrangement for the ladies will prevail. Mixed games may be arranged.

LEAGUE RULES:

- 1 Any person playing in the league must be a member of the Farnborough Recreation Centre and the Bowling Club.
- 2 In all leagues, each team shall have at least 6 playing members.
- 3 All leagues are of 18 ends or 2 hours duration, with the exception of the National/Div. 1. League which will be a full 21 end game of 3 hours duration.
- 4 In all League games, the jack shall be delivered not placed. If, however, the jack is delivered out of the rink the opposing skip has the right to place the jack. If during a league game the jack is put out of the confines of the rink the end is considered an end played without penalty.
- 5 In view of the time restriction in all two hour games Skips are not allowed to:-
 - a) Remain at head whilst opposing slip bowls firstwood.
 - b) To follow wood down rink when played.
 - c) To inspect head.
- 6 In a mixed league team at least one playing member must be of the opposite sex.
- 7 A league match may not be postponed. Rule 9 to apply for cancelled games.
- 8 When a league game is played without the full complement. The game to be started at the normal time - the leads and twos of the offending team using only two woods for the first two ends. At the start of the third end the late arrival may start play and a normal game played.

If team still depleted the leads and twos should then use three woods and no additional player allowed to join the game. At the end of the game the offending team will lose 25% of its score to the nearest whole number - a half being counted as one, ie. - 5% deduct 5 - 5% deduct 6 - 5% deduct 6.

- 9 Should a league team fail to attend the game will be conceded to the non-offending side and 3 points plus 10 shots awarded. The defaulting team will be responsible for the cost of the rink.
- 10 If play is stopped because of an emergency outside our control, the result will stand if 5 or more ends have been played.

R.I.B.C. COMPETITION RULES

- 1 Any player competing must be a current member of Farnborough Recreation Centre and the Bowling Club.
- 2 Players taking part in the first game will constitute the team, after which one substitute only may be used by any one team, and any such substitute should be advised to the respective Competition Secretary within 24 hours of the game being played.
- 3 Competitors must put their Bowls Club number on the back of the score card.
- 4 a) SINGLES - First to the number of shots approved by the E.I.B.A. or E.W.I.B.A., as appropriate, or two hours duration. Finals to be played to the winner achieving the required number of shots.
b) PAIRS - TRIPLES - RINKS - Games to be of 18 ends or 2 hours duration. FINALS - Full game to be played.
c) DRAWN GAMES - In the event of a drawn game the competitor with the most winning ends be declared the winner. If this does not produce a winner, score at previous end to count.
- 5 In view of the time restriction in all two hour games skips are not allowed to:-
a) remain at head whilst opposing skip bowls first wood.

NATIONALS

As laid down by the E.I.B.A. and E.W.I.B.A. for 3 hour rink bookings players must use their respective National League times or play out of Club time.

- 11 The bell will be rung 5 minutes before the end of the session after which no further end may be commenced.
- 12 Owing to the great cost of the indoor jacks it is the responsibility of the skip to return the jack and to put the completed score-card in the box provided.
- 13 National Competitions will take priority, so it may, therefore, be necessary to change league or other games to another rink, and it is hoped all players will co-operate if the occasion should arise.
- 14 Captains are to notify the Hon. League Secretary of any additions to their playing strength not on the original league registration list.

- b) to follow wood down rink when played.
- c) to inspect head.
- d) no trial ends for 2 hour duration games.

- 6 If jack is sent out of the rink - end to be replayed.
- 7 Jack must not be delivered after 5 minutes before completion time.
- 8 Winners of Mens Competitions qualify for County play off.
- 9 Games may be played before the scheduled date with approval of Opponent and Competition Secretary. The cost to be the responsibility of the player requesting the change.
- 10 CONCEDED GAMES - The respective Competition Secretary must be notified immediately concession is known. The cost of an unused rink is the responsibility of the defaulter/s.
- 11 Competitions must be commenced within 10 minutes of starting time otherwise conceded. Should, at this time, any team be without the full complement, they shall forfeit the game. Defaulters to pay the cost.
- 12 Competition Committee shall consist of respective President, Competition Secretary and one other.

EXECUTIVE SECRETARY'S REPORT

I take much pleasure in presenting the eighth Annual Report of the Rushmoor Indoor Bowling Club.

Since our last Annual General Meeting the Executive Committee has met on nine occasions plus the General Meeting in September. A member of Centre has been present at most Meetings. We all endeavour to do our best for the Club although not all decisions taken can always suit every individual. The Committee are only human and mistakes do occasionally occur — we can only apologize for this and trust that no irreparable damage has been suffered.

The total membership for this season amounted to 678 — 20 in excess of last season. With Camberley opening later this year we expect this number to drop a little but it would appear, nevertheless, that all leagues will be full. Our total commitment to the Centre next season will be £20,593 — 95p — an increase of 15p per hour on daytime leagues and 20p per hour on evening leagues. Taking daytime car parking charges into account Green Fees have been slightly re-adjusted for next season.

Having mentioned the Camberley Club — may I, on behalf of the Rushmoor Club wish every success to Camberley and to those members leaving here — just say — we shall miss you but we thank you for the support you have given us over the years.

I am delighted to be the person to congratulate the ladies who did so well in the National Competitions. May Carter, Betty Bush and Win Ford reached the area sub-zone finals having beaten, on the way, well known International Mavis Steele M.B.E. on her home green. They went on to win the sub-zone final and were beaten by only 6 shots in the full zone final. Well done ladies — as you are all going to Camberley we wish you success next season until you meet our ladies. Stella Moores and Patricia Hase reached the sub-zone finals of the pairs — only to be beaten by two shots by the said Mavis Steele — she couldn't be beaten twice by Rushmoor players could she? Well done.

Matthew Short reached the last sixteen of the National under 25 Competition where he represented the Club at Melton Mowbray. Our congratulations Matthew.

Bill Short, our last season's Cockney Classic winner lost to the previous year's finalist — but nevertheless was a standard bearer for the Club.

Bill Short and Malcolm Wanless were the losing finalists in the Hampshire County Pairs. The Club thanks all members who do so much to enhance the name of Rushmoor.

Congratulations must also be awarded to the Mallards, whom we admire so much, for their successes particularly at the Paralympics in Seoul. Your help is again needed for the Disabled Regional Bowls Championship to be held here on Saturday 14th May and also for the Les Haute Competition on the 10th and 11th June. More about this from Mr. Tingey later.

The Easter Tournament, which again was a very successful day, was won by Mr. and Mrs. Carter, Mrs. Moores and Mr. Dadswell. The runners-up were Mr. and Mrs. Pape and Mr. and Mrs. Ford.

The Sunday Double-Rink Competition winners were Windlesham with Brightwell runners-up. The best losers final was not played owing to one team not being available. Due to the Calendar this Competition will again have to start early next season — that is on the 17th September.

It falls my pleasure to thank Mr. and Mrs. Hase for the conscientious way in which they have carried out their duties as respective Presidents.

To those Committee Members who will be leaving we offer our heartfelt thanks for all the work done. Special mention must be made of Mrs. Bush (Treasurer) who has looked after every penny — To Mr. Mayhew for attending to the leagues and to Mr. Evans who has worked very hard dealing with the friendly games.

My personal thanks to all members of the Club who tolerate me so well and to the Executive Committee who must be tired of the sound of my voice.

Which brings me to a point I made last year — Loddon Vale Indoor Bowling Club, Basingstoke, is scheduled for opening in 1990 (next year).
