Nottinghamshire County Council

High Street footpaths and 2 cul-de-sacs on the Lawns in need of reconstruction have been proposed to be included in the forward programme of works for Footways. Braemar Road which is in need of reconstruction has been proposed to be included in the forward programme of works for Highways. Officers will now consider and determine if suitable. Any work will not commence before the beginning of the next financial year 2020/21. A speed limit review is being considered by officers and it may be another 6

The overnight HGV ban is to have alterations at the Winthorpe Roundabout, which will involve the relocation of the advance signs, now that Highways



England have given permission for this to be done. The signs will now be located on the A46, before lorries turn on to the A1133.

The Parish Council enquired if it would be possible to downgrade the High Street to a "B" road. Cllr Dobson did not believe that this would alter the amount of traffic on the road.
