

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, VARIOUS ROADS, DORCHESTER

- NIGHT WORKS

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. The Order comes in to operation on 15 June 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 June 2026. Works will be carried out between 2000hrs and 0600hrs.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out essential highway maintenance works.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

[1] To impose temporary road closure on Weymouth Avenue between its junctions with Tesco roundabout and Edward Road as and when indicated by signs on site. [2] To impose temporary clearway on Weymouth Avenue between its junctions with Tesco roundabout and Edward Road as and when indicated by signs on site. [3] To impose temporary road closure on Weymouth Avenue between its junctions with Dray Horse Yard and South Walks Road as and when indicated by signs on site. [4] To impose temporary clearway on Weymouth Avenue between its junctions with Dray Horse Yard and South Walks Road as and when indicated by signs on site. [5] To impose temporary road closure on South Walks Road between its junctions with Weymouth Avenue and Icen Way as and when indicated by signs on site. [6] To impose temporary clearway on South Walks Road between its junctions with Weymouth Avenue and Icen Way as and when indicated by signs on site.

Please note that any vehicle waiting in contravention of temporary parking restrictions may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been removed, the owner must contact the Council's vehicle recovery contractor: Ashleywood Recovery Ltd/Bride Valley Recovery Ltd on 01305 889421.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
